

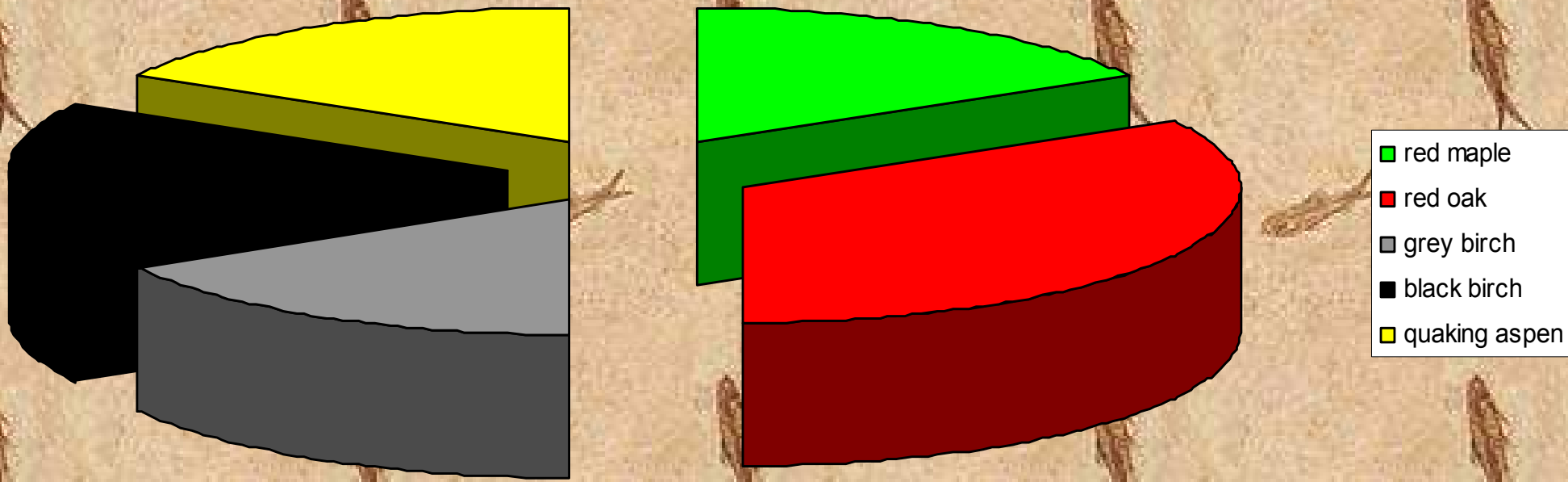
An Explosion of Oaky Sights

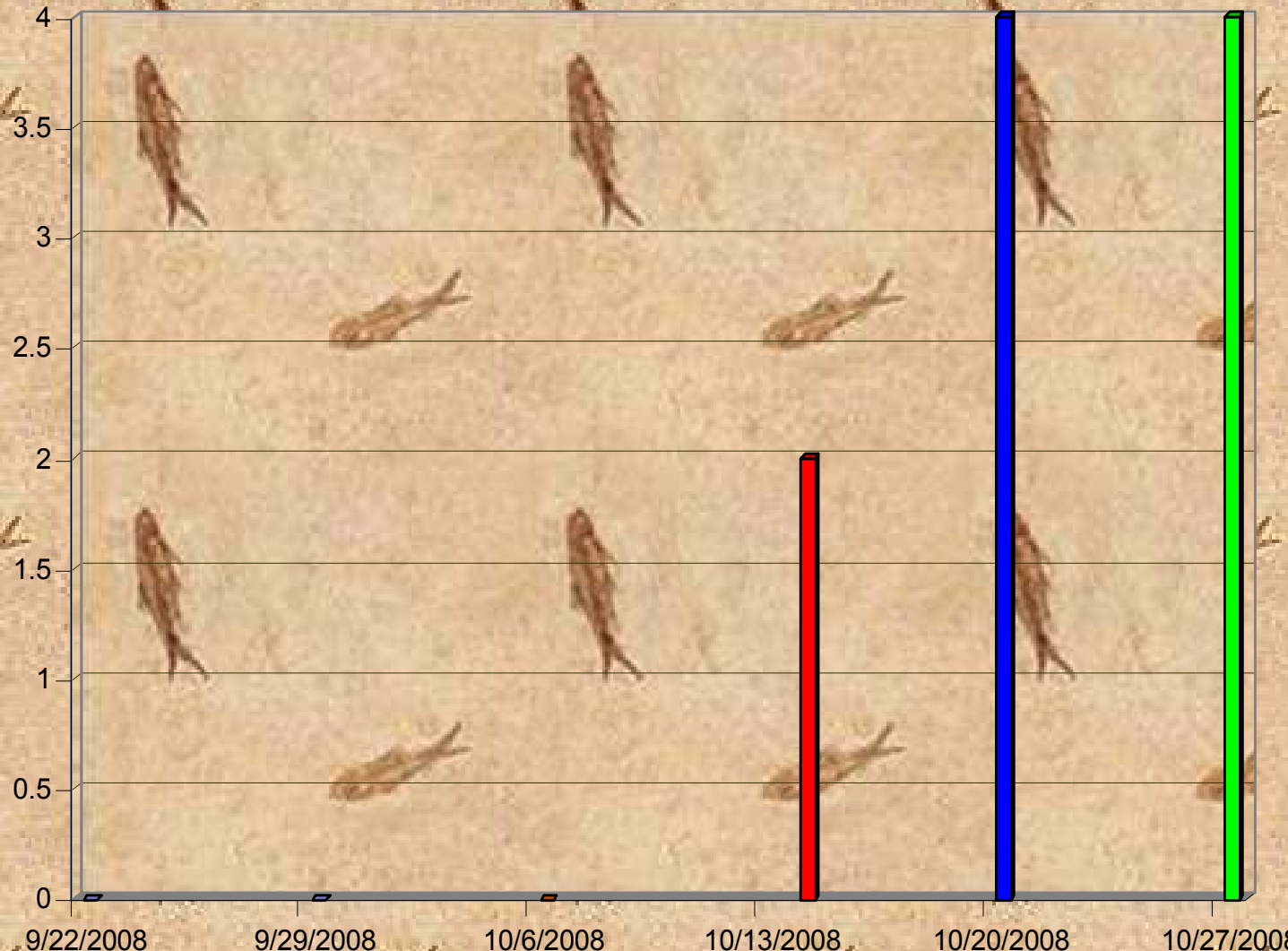
