

Web Page Publishing Permission Form

Notice of Possible Publication of Certain Student Information During the School Year

The district has created a Web Page Publishing Policy to ensure student safety. You can find the full text of that policy in the John R. Briggs Student Handbook. What follows is a quick summary of the policy and a permission slip that you can use to grant or deny permission to publish information on your child. If a parent or guardian fails to complete/return the form, the district will treat that act as a DENIAL of consent, until otherwise notified in writing by the parent/guardian.

Only two types of student information will be published on the Briggs web page:

1. The first names and grade levels of students who are being recognized for special achievement (winning the spelling bee, being selected for an all-star team, etc.);
2. Work that students have created in class (a poem written in language arts, a picture of a clay pot created in art, etc.), identified by the student's first name and grade level.

At the elementary level, NO last names or pictures will be published. Student telephone numbers and home addresses will NOT be posted on any school web page.
