

My Red Oak Tree Study

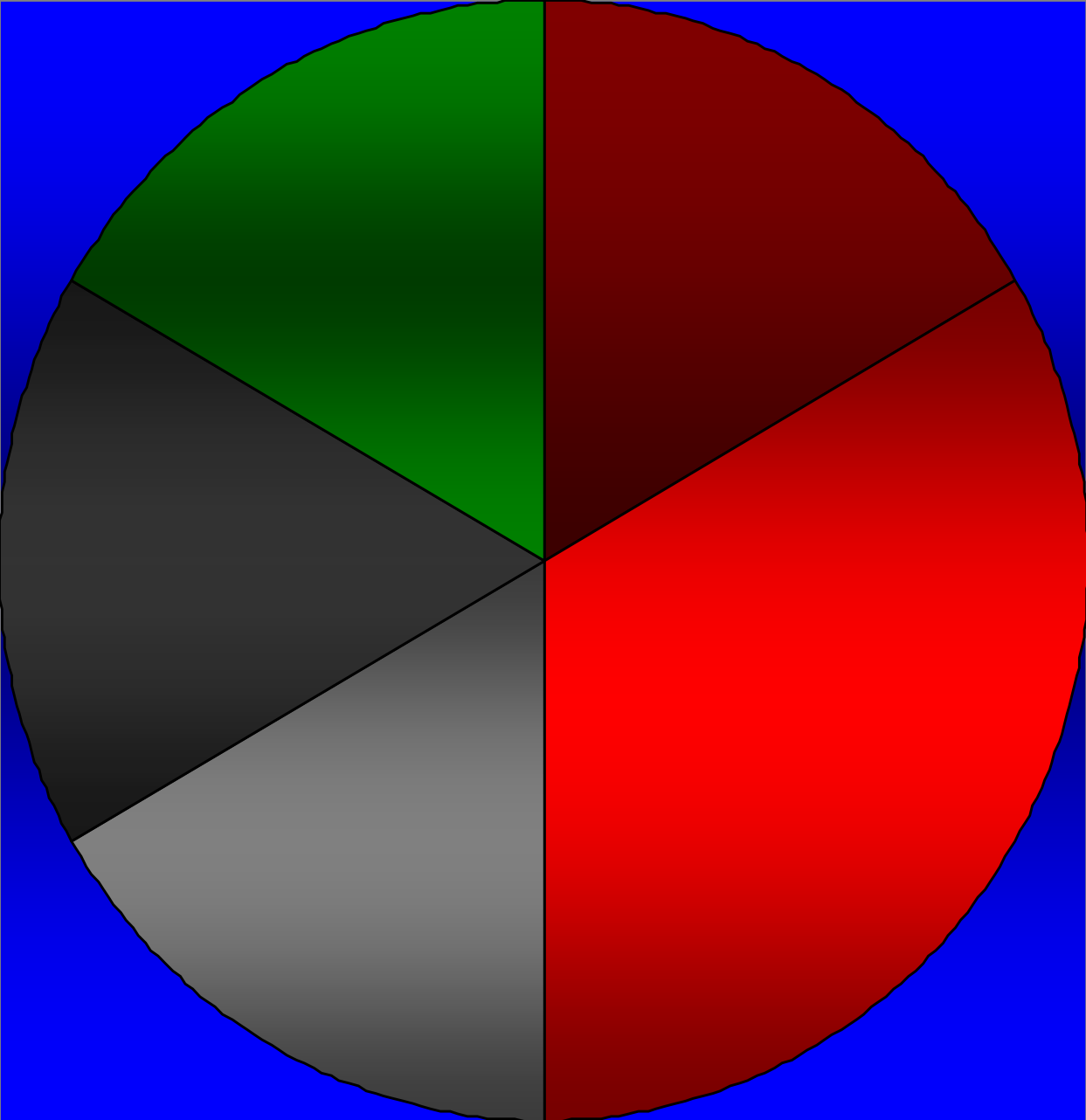

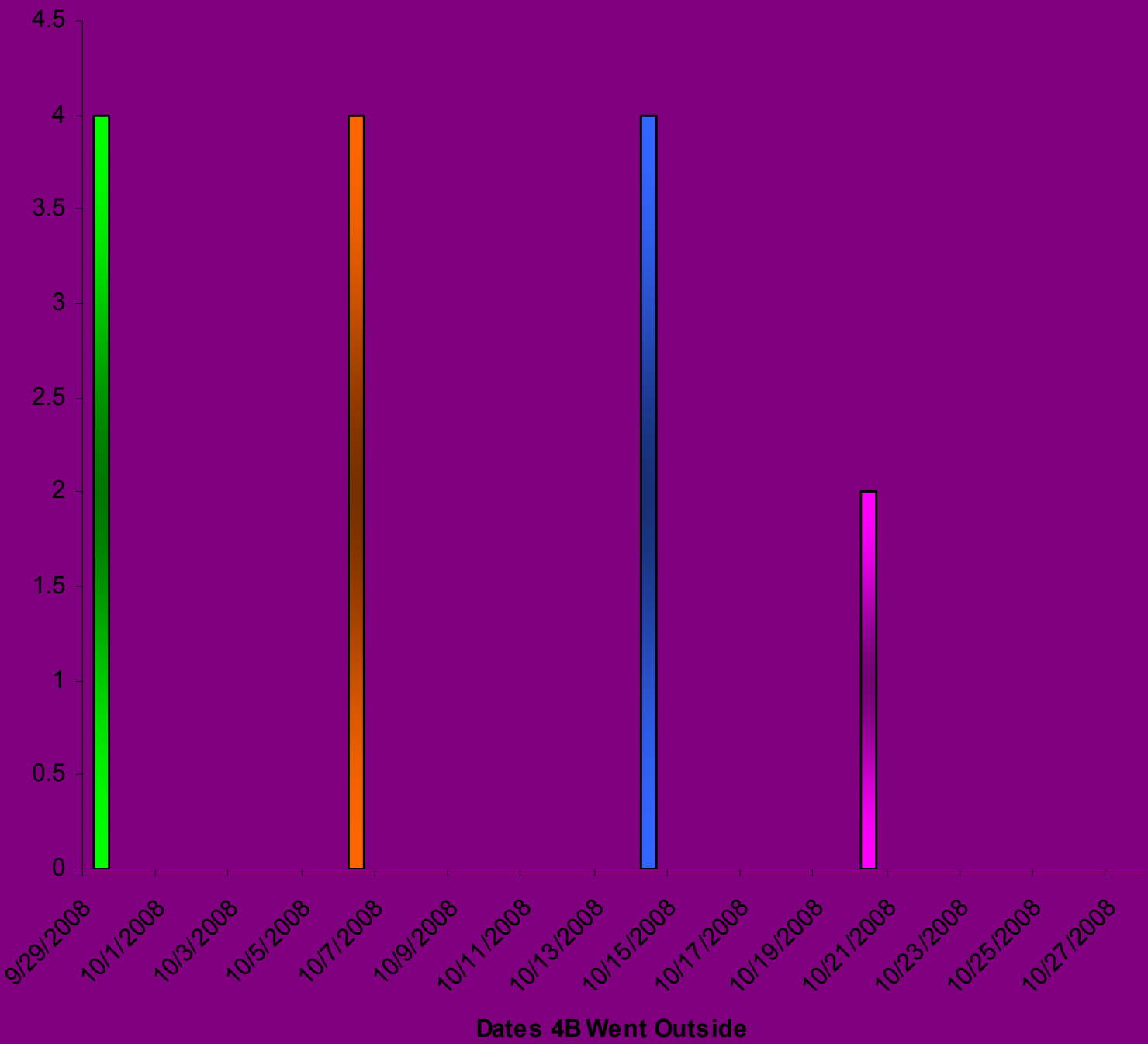
How Many Trees 4B Has by Alicia Cournoyer
