

My Beech Tree



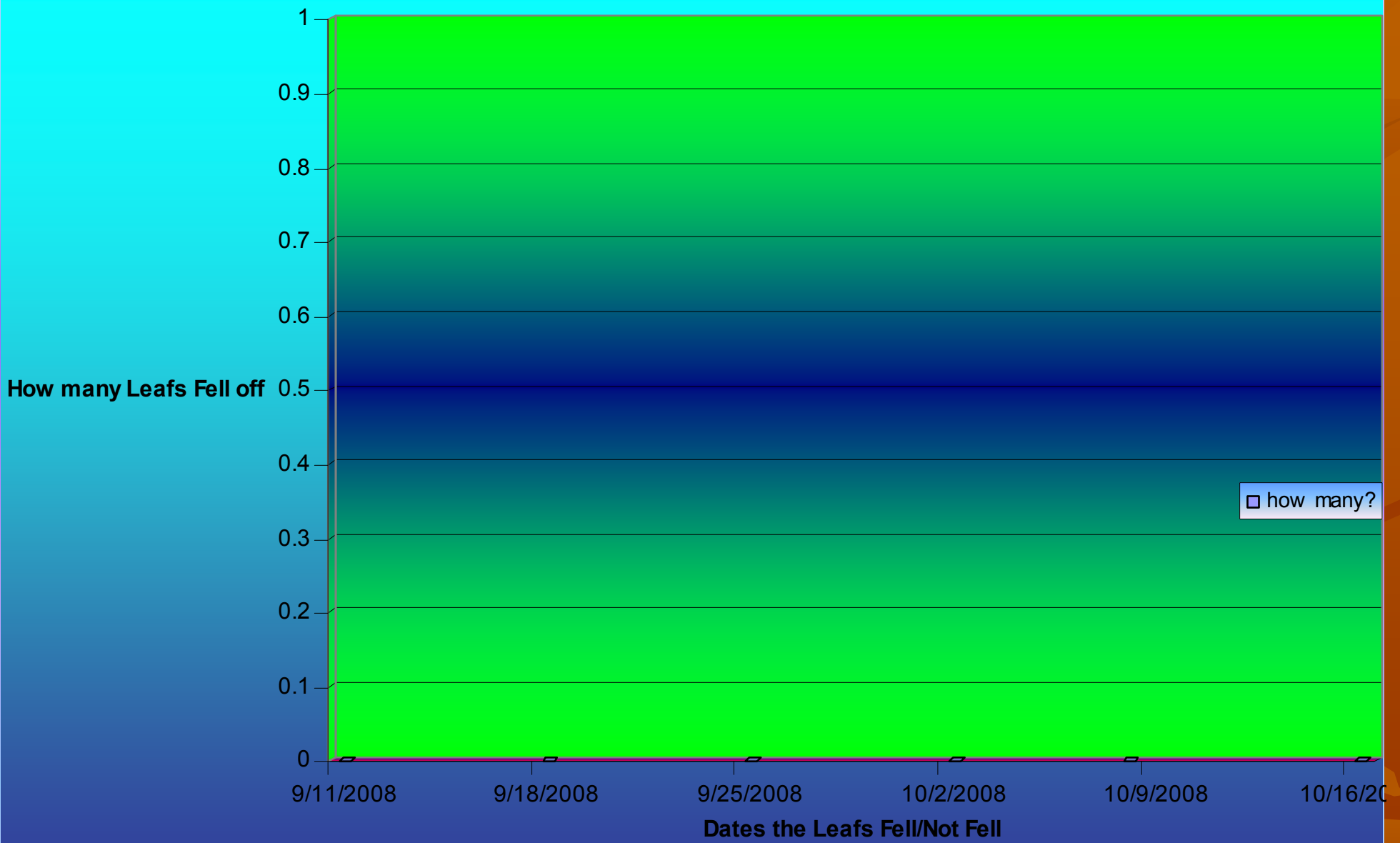

Overview

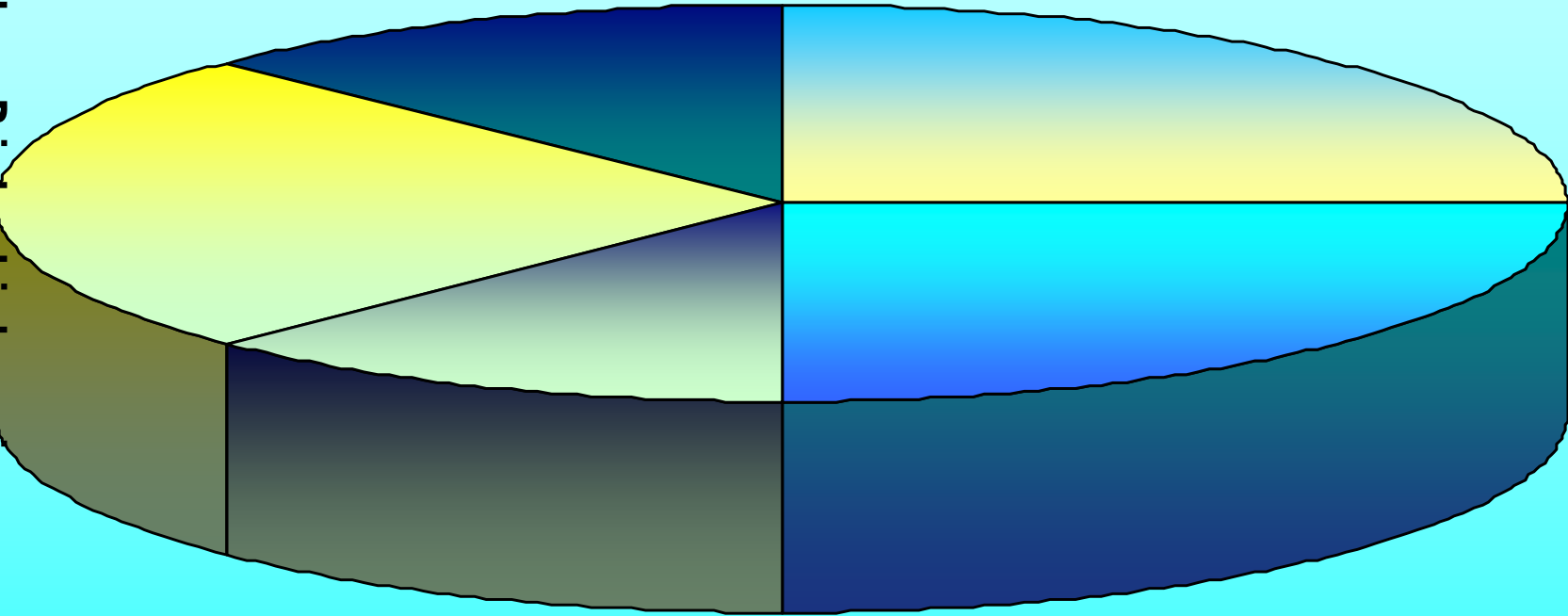
