- **Program of Studies Changes**-looking at revising Biology curriculum (grade 9 Bio class, and maybe adding AP Bio?), and we're also offering AP Statistics next year (minimal impact to master schedule). Will also look at AP Calculus and AP Literature to see if they can go everyday in second semester (right now the schedule is every other day in second semester). Much more discussion required before any changes are made, want to include the new Superintendent in the decision-making process.
