- NAME:** First Name, Middle name (Optional), Last Name
- QUOTE:** no more than 100 characters including spaces and author.
- BLURB:** 600 - 1200 characters; this includes your name, quote, all spaces and punctuation.
- Formatting:**
 - Arial 12 pt font
 - DO NOT USE ONLY CAPITAL LETTERS
 - No more than 1200 Characters TOTAL and no less than 600 Characters

- 2 PHOTOS:** Senior Photo & Baby photo (or other photo). We need JPGS of your Photos or Hard Copies in an envelope. (300 DPI is required for digital images)
Make sure your NAME & HOMEROOM is on the back of each photo.
- SHARE:** All info must be **SHARED** on Google Form with OakmontYearbook@awrsd.org (Always **SAVE IT** to your computer, or just in case, e-mail it to yourself or save as a Google Doc). Once submitted, **IT IS DONE NO CHANGES CAN BE MADE.**
- DEADLINE:** If your Senior Packet is turned in AFTER **September 20th, 2019** a **\$30 fine will be imposed** because it is **LATE** or it is **INCOMPLETE**. We will not accept any photos or blurbs after **September 21th 2018!** And you will be listed as camera shy.
